To the Parents/Guardians of **Current 6**<sup>th</sup> **Grade Students:** 

Texas State law requires that each child attending public school be immunized against certain vaccine-preventable diseases. As your student prepares to enter the 7<sup>th</sup> grade in the 2024-2025 school year, they will be required to show acceptable evidence of their adolescent vaccinations (Tdap and Meningococcal) <u>prior</u> to the first day of school. **Without the proper documentation of required vaccinations, or a valid medical or conscientious exemption, students will not be allowed to be in attendance.** 

Please provide a copy of your student's updated shot record to your Campus Registrar **no later than August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024** to ensure enrollment on the first day of classes, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Included in this notice you will find the 2024-2025 Texas Minimum State Vaccine Requirements for Students Grade K-12 for your review. Additionally, only the MCV4 quadrivalent Meningococcal vaccine will be accepted by the State for enrollment.
